


Fake-a-Flake


Here's a little art activity for you to enjoy too. Simply follow the instructions to make your very own hand-crafted Christmas snowflake. It's fun, relaxing and creating something yourself is always satisfying, as is knowing you're helping Scotland's children have a fantastic Christmas. When you've finished your snowflake you can either hang it from your tree with a piece of tape and the string supplied, or stick it in your window using double sided tape or White Tack.


You'll then be guaranteed at least one beautiful snowflake on Christmas morning. Decorate and share your finished snowflake with your friends and Aberlour on Facebook.




1. First cut along the horizontal line to separate the instructions




2. Fold over by a third again to end up with this shape.



3. Now you have a square piece of paper. Fold along the dotted line to make a triangle.




4. Next cut straight across the bottom.




5. Now fold the triangle in half to make a smaller triangle.



6. Cut into the folded shape using the dotted lines for your cuts.



7. Fold the triangle into thirds using the dotted line for guidance.



8. Gently unfold to see your finished snowflake. You can stick this to a window on your tree by taping to the end of the string.
